1. OVERVIEW OF PROJECT PROGRESS

1.1 Progress in Brief:

During the third quarter, the project main focus was to build capacities of the beneficiaries in order to strengthen them to undertake future project interventions. Therefore, six field level awareness and training programs were carried out under three main segments i.e. Climate Smart Home Gardening, Water Conservation and Environment Conservation which will assist to achieve the overall project objective. Under the Climate Smart Home Gardening (CSHG) Program, two training programs were carried out enabling beneficiaries to initiate (CSHGs). For this CSHGs Bio intensive farming practices will be introduced where beneficiaries can grow vegetables /fruits using 67% - 88% less water while using the fraction of the resources. Under the environment conservation segment, two training programs were carried out on the establishment and management of domestic plant nurseries. The objective of these domestic plant nurseries is to acquire the required plants for the catchment conservation program under the project. Under the water conservation and management plan, one awareness program was carried out on soil conservation methods and the importance of establishing contour soil bunds enabling beneficiaries to take an active role in water management and conservation.

Significantly, Government technical line agencies were linked with the project, particularly, the Provincial Department of Agriculture and Department of Animal Production & Health extended their technical assistance to carry out the field training programs.

1.2 Activities undertaken:

- An initial awareness program on the establishment and management of domestic plant nurseries carried out for 20 (11F, 09M) beneficiaries with the technical assistance of the Provincial Department of Agriculture. The objective of this awareness session was to educate beneficiaries about the basic concepts of maintaining a domestic level plant nursery.
- Two hands-on training programs on the establishment and management of domestic plant nurseries carried out for 28 (13F, 15M) beneficiaries with the technical assistance of the Provincial Department of Agriculture. The objective of this awareness session was to provide practical training on domestic plant nursery management for the beneficiaries enabling them to initiate their plant nurseries.







- Two Climate Smart Home Gardening(CSHG) awareness programs were carried out for 33 (18F, 15M) beneficiaries enabling them to initiate CSHGs in the month of October 2019. A training program was conducted by an Agriculture Specialist who specialized in Biointensive farming practice and with the technical assistance of Agriculture Instructor- Department of Agriculture. It is expected to initiate Climate Smart Home Gardens incorporating Biointensive farming practices in the month of October 2019. Furthermore, it is earmarked to provide drought resistance traditional vegetable seed varieties to the beneficiaries which required less amount of water.
- An awareness program and a field demonstration carried out for 20 (12F, 08M) beneficiaries on soil conservation measures facilitating them to establish/assist in establishing contour soil bunds in their home gardens.
- Two awareness programs on dairy farming and free- range poultry farming were carried out 22(2F 20M) beneficiaries with the technical assistance of the Department of Animal Production & Health. The objective of this awareness session was to educate the beneficiaries on livestock development in the village as an alternative income source. Therefore, the project will take future actions to assist the selected number of beneficiaries to improve their livestock activities.
