1. OVERVIEW OF PROJECT PROGRESS

1.1 Progress in Brief:

During the second quarter, the project has earmarked to initiate ground level implementations with the completion of project inauguration meeting, stakeholder awareness and base line survey. Therefore, three main project activities i.e. Initiation of community based plant nurseries, implementation of climate smart home gardens and School awareness program with the celebration of world environment day 2019 were originally planned to be carried out in the reporting period.

Following activities were carried out during the reporting period.

- A tree planting program carried out by the Kudadoanaththawa community members, planting 100 native trees.
- A programme to celebrate World Environment Day Of 2019 organized and held in Rambakanayagama Primary School.
- Beneficiary selection for the implementation of climate smart home gardens completed
- Classroom and Field level awareness programs carried out for 26 farmers on climate smart home garden implementation

Planned activity to establish community based plant nurseries during the second quarter of 2019 has been rescheduled by expecting adequate rain in the third and fourth quarter of 2019. Therefore, Handson training on domestic plant nursery establishment and the provision of plant nursery equipment for the beneficiaries too have been rescheduled.

1.2 Activities undertaken:

 A tree planting program organized and, carried out by the Kudadoanaththawa community members, planting 100 native trees. i.e, Kumbuk (Terminalia arjuna), Mee (Madhuca longifolia), & Karada (Pongamia pinnata) at the Village temple premises. The objective of the activity was to







emphasize the importance of the tree cover in protecting water resources in the village. There were 25 community members who took part in this initiative helping the environment to make their village green.

- In partnership with the Divisional Secretariat, 2019 World Environment Day celebration program organized in Rambakanayagama Primary School. Nawagaththegama. The objective of this program was to educate school children and their parents regarding the importance of environmental conservation. Therefore, school awareness program and art competition carried out and prizes were awarded to the winners. Nearly 100 students and 46 parents participated in this event.
- Completed the beneficiary selection for the initiation of climate smart home gardens which will
 facilitate for the respective beneficiaries to learn and practice the drought resistant farming
 technologies.
- Following the beneficiary selection, climate smart home gardening awareness and planning program carried out with the participation of 18 project beneficiaries. The objective of this program was to make the beneficiaries aware on the importance of adapting the climate smart agriculture technologies in their farming practices. Furthermore, participants were enlightened on the basic concepts of climate smart agriculture practices.
- A village transect walk carried out with the participation of 16 project beneficiaries to identify the
 current home gardening practices particularly to identify the water saving farming techniques
 adopted in the home gardens and gaps to be addressed by the project interventions.

1.3 Involvement of different project partners, including the target groups

Since the Divisional Secretariat (DS) is one of the key partners, the project received fullest cooperation from the Divisional Secretary and his subordinate officers. Furthermore, Zonal Department of Education has endorsed their support by providing their concurrence to carry out the environmental education program and world environment day celebration at the village school. Therefore, school teachers and parents of the school children actively involved with the project activities.

1.4 Challenges or difficulties faced within the project implementation:

No challenges or difficulties faced so far and SAPSRI is optimistic of implementing the project as scheduled.

1.5 Financial Progress

The Project was able to record an expenditure of Rs. 131,025.00 for this quarter. The details are given in Annex -02
